PASSPORT DIRECTIONS

To assemble the passport:

- Cut the cover page in half and fold the paper
- Cut several pieces of a regular 8.5 x 11 paper in half
- Fold the pieces and staple it in the middle of the booklet

Each time your child finishes reading a book, pick the corresponding "passport stamp" → cut it out, and glue it on any page → just as they do in the immigration/airports of the world.
